Elisabeth Namchevadze was born in a family of musicians in 2008. She had her first piano lesson at the age of 4. For the last seven years in a row she's been winning 1st prize at the "Jugend Musiziert" competition in Germany. In 2018 she achieved the 1st prize and the "Mozart's prize" at the "Tonkünstler" competition in Stuttgart.
